Thank you for your prayers over the past 12 months, over the next year I ask you to pray for our missional activity in the communities of Mastrick, Northfield and Summerhill; to pray for the continuing building of connections with other churches in the area and to ask God for His guidance and blessing in all that we do in His name.

Serving our Community Together

The past few months have been incredibly busy as we've embarked on a variety of new projects to serve and connect with our community.

During the October school holidays, we were thrilled to host our Pizza Pilgrims Pizza Making workshops for children from across the city. The kids had so much fun getting hands-on with food, learning new skills, and expressing their creativity. The workshops were a huge hit—so much so that we were over-

subscribed! I'm delighted to share that due to popular demand, the workshops will return during the school in-service days in February.

In early November, we also welcomed the Riding Lights Theatre Company for a special performance of Cups on a String, a heart-warming and powerful play. The performance marked the launch of our involvement with Transforming Lives for Good's (TLG) Early Intervention Mentoring Project. This programme will see us working alongside Northfield UF and Sheddocksley Baptist Church to mentor children at Westpark Primary. The Cups on a String performance, set the tone for what we pray will be a transformative partnership.

Thanks to a successful application to the Co-op Community Fund, we've been awarded a minimum of £1,000 to enhance our café with a community fridge and food pantry. This amount could increase as people become members of the Co-op and choose Aberdeen North as their local cause.
